ACCESSING YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY ACCOUNT INFORMATION

Did you know that you can access your Social Security Account on-line to do the following:

- Get a statement to verify your social security earnings that have posted to your account over the course of your working years;
- Find out an estimate of your future retirement benefits if you are still working or disability payments if you were to become disabled;
- Obtain a letter from the Social Security Administration that provides proof of your benefits if you are receiving them now;
- Change your mailing address;
- Start or change your direct deposit;
- Get a replacement Medicare card; and
- Get a replacement Form SSA-1099 or SSA-1042S for income tax purposes.

It is easy to set up an account and it is quick and secure.

You also have the option to receive your Social Security Statement by mail. To do so, please print and complete a "Request For Social Security Statement" (Form SSA-7004) and mail it to the address provided on the form. You should receive your paper Social Security Statement in the mail in four to six weeks.
